I've seen traces of color only on the Moon and brightest planets and stars. Contrast is unusually high. Includes a nesting dewcap and a fully rotating JMI Crayford type tailpiece. Also comes with a 2" mirror diagonal, 1¼" adaptor, Stellarvue tube rings, and a soft padded Stellarvue carry case. Combined original cost over \$1175. Sell for \$850.
